Criteria and Purpose

The Greater Victoria Eldercare Foundation actively supports learning opportunities that will enhance excellence in care giving at facilities and programs supported by the Eldercare Foundation. The Foundation's Staff Education Fund (formerly The Staff Memorial Fund) helps to accomplish this aim by supporting group education projects on relevant topics. Projects must be supported by Managers, Clinical Nurse Educators, or on-site Education committees or other professional staff groups working with the residents and/or patients of facilities and programs supported by the Eldercare Foundation.

Eligibility and Expectations

1. Projects must be oriented toward staff education
2. Successful applicants must show how they will recognize the Eldercare Foundation for the grant received.
3. Successful applicants must submit a brief summary of the project's outcomes within 60 days of the completion of the project to the Awards Committee of the Eldercare Foundation.

Application Process

1. Applications must include the following:
 - Purpose of the project.
 - Intended audience to benefit from project.
 - Estimated cost or detailed budget
 - Other relevant details
2. Projects can be submitted to the Eldercare Foundation either before or after completion.
3. The Awards Committee of the Eldercare Foundation will review the application in a timely fashion and give approval within the projected timelines for the project.

Funding

- Up to \$500 annually per site
- Up to \$1000 annually if project benefits multiple sites.
